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## How do I Migrate from Myvisiononline (My Vision Online) to Patient Services?

The website your practice uses for online patient services is changing. When your practice switches to the new service, you must migrate from [www.myvisiononline.co.uk](http://www.myvisiononline.co.uk) account to the new service, [www.patient-services.co.uk](http://www.patient-services.co.uk), this may involve setting up a new user name and password.

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**!** **Important** - [www.patient-services.co.uk](http://www.patient-services.co.uk) is created and maintained by Vision, who continue to develop and maintain it. When you migrate to the new website you need to record your personal details and complete new security details. This enables Vision to assist you with any technical issues should they arise.

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### How do I Migrate to Patient Services?

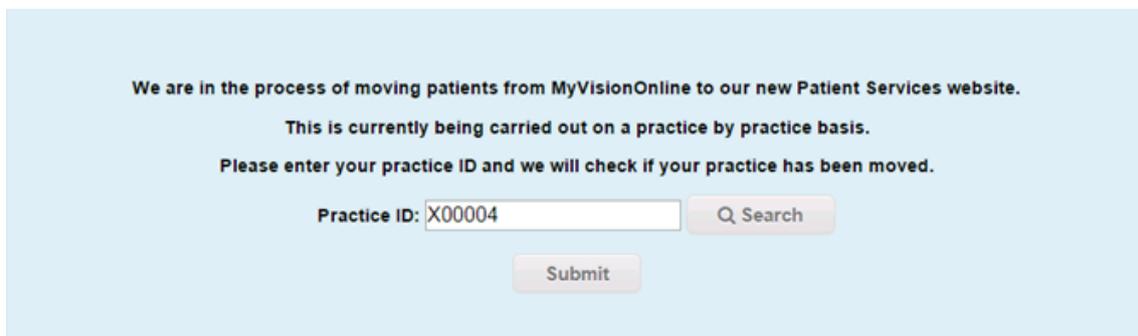
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**!** **Important** - **This is for existing [www.myvisiononline.co.uk](http://www.myvisiononline.co.uk) users only.** If you have already been through the migration process, you must log in to [www.patient-services.co.uk](http://www.patient-services.co.uk). If you have never registered for Online Services please refer to your GP practice for details.

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To Migrate to Patient Services:

1. When you login to [www.myvisiononline.co.uk](http://www.myvisiononline.co.uk), the following message is displayed, enter your **Practice ID** or select on **Search** to find it and select **Submit**.

2. The **Sign In** screen is displayed, enter your existing username and password and select **Sign In** .
3. Once your GP Practice is ready, the following message is displayed, select [here](#) to continue.

**4.** The Migration screen is displayed, enter your existing password again and select **Next**.

**5.** The **Account Details** screen is displayed, and needs to be completed:

- **Username** - you can reuse your old username, (providing it meets the criteria displayed on screen), if this has already been used by someone else you will have to create a new one, that is unique to you, suggestions are displayed should you want to use them.

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 **Note** - The only symbols allowed here are dots and dashes, so you cannot currently use your email address

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- **Password** - Type a new password, this must be a minimum of 8 characters containing at least one character from three of the following four character types
  - Uppercase letter
  - Lowercase letter
  - A number
  - A symbol.
- **Confirm Password** - Retype the new password to confirm.

**6.** Read the **Terms and Conditions** and **Privacy Policy** and tick to agree.

**7.** Select **Confirm**  to create your account.

**8.** The **Migration Complete** screen is displayed, select **Home**  to go to the Patient Services home page.
